STANDING RULE 1.

Table I: Fees and Dues

These are the required fee and dues for the Texas and National Societies. Each chapter may set additional fees and dues.

Dues of members admitted **after March 15** shall be applied to the succeeding year beginning **October 1**.

Upon approval by the National or the Texas Societies, changes shall be made automatically to this table without further action by the State Secretary. *Revision of Standing Rule approved September 7, 2016.

STANDING RULE 2.

A standard form to facilitate transfer of members shall be used by the chapters. Form will be included in the chapter President's packet at the September Workshop and may be copied.

TRANSFER PROCEDURE:

The member contacts the chapter to which she wishes to transfer.

- a. The receiving chapter votes on acceptance of the member and initiates the transfer form.
- b. The **receiving chapter completes the Change in Membership Status form and mails three copies to the State President with a \$2.00 check made to transfer member's current chapter.** (for application copy cost and postage).
- c. Upon receipt of the Change in Membership Status forms, the State President signs and dates the forms.
- d. The State President sends one copy to the Corresponding Secretary National, one copy with check to the previous chapter, and one copy for State records.
- e. The previous chapter makes a copy of the transferring member's approved application papers and sends them to the receiving chapter.
- f. The State president makes the necessary adjustments to the state membership roster.

STANDING RULE 3.

REINSTATEMENT PROCEDURE:

- a. A former member desiring reinstatement should make her wish known to the chapter she wishes to join.
- b. Upon vote of acceptance by that chapter, she shall pay the chapter the reinstatement fee and the national, state and chapter dues for the current year.
- c. The **chapter treasurer shall send to the State Treasurer:**
 - 1) **A check made payable to the Texas Society,** for the reinstatement fee and the state and national dues.
- d. **THREE copies** of the completed Change in Membership Status form.
- e. The State Treasurer shall send the completed forms with a check, made payable to the Treasurer National, for the reinstatement fee and the national dues to the State President for approval. The State President shall sign the forms and send the forms and the check to the President National.
